Adopt-a-Drain Competition

Northeast Neighborhood Storm Drain Competition

Audubon Neighborhood is challenging all the Northeast Neighborhoods to an Adopt-a-Drain Competition.


In Northeast Minneapolis, all of the storm drains lead directly to the Mississippi River. By adopting drains and pledging to keep them clean, we can prevent pollution from entering the river, improve our water quality, and prevent local flooding.

The competition starts May 1st and ends October 31st, 2020. To participate, go to adopt-a-drain.org to sign up. Once your drain is adopted, keep your drain clean by sweeping leaves and other debris off the drain surface. You can also track your efforts online.

We will post monthly program updates, including top participants from the Bottineau Neighborhood.

The winning neighborhood will be announced in late Fall.

No Cost Financing & Free Energy Audits

The City of Minneapolis is helping residents save money and increase comfort in their homes. While funds last, the City is offering 0% financing on recommended energy-saving upgrades to all households (no income limit) and free Home Energy Squad visits to households with a family income less than \$100,000.

All residents living in a Minneapolis Green Zone are eligible for the free energy visit regardless of income: Bottineau, Cedar-Riverside, East Phillips, Hawthorne, Marshall Terrace, McKinley, Midtown Phillips, Near North, Phillips West, Sheridan and Ventura Village.

Recycle Smart Campaign

Throughout 2019 Minneapolis Solid Waste & Recycling partnered with Hennepin County and the City of St. Paul on the **Recycle Smart campaign**. The campaign focused on providing education about some of the most problematic and frequent contamination items found in recycling carts.

Keeping non-recyclable items out of your cart helps reduce challenges with collection, sorting, and processing your items into something new. If you put the right things in your cart, they will be recycled. Recycle Smart, do your part and pledge to only put the right items in your recycling cart.

Always recycle:

Mail, office and school papers, Magazines, newspaper and inserts, Boxes (food, beverage, toiletries, Cardboard. Steel and aluminum cans. Glass jars and bottles, Plastic bottles, containers, jugs (#1, 2, 5), Cartons (milk, broth, juice)

Never recycle:

Plastic bags, Bagged recycling, Large plastic items (laundry baskets, storage tubs, toys), Random metal items (pots and pans, pipes and poles, hangers), Food-soiled paper (napkins, paper towels, paper plates, fast-food wrap), Straws and utensils. Electronics and batteries, Hazardous materials (motor oil, propane tanks, etc.). Medical waste (sharps: needles and syringes, lancets), Tangles (hoses, cords, holiday lights, etc.) minneapolismn.gov/solid-waste
