Did you know that all MN voters are eligible to vote early by mail? To minimize direct contact with others, the CDC encourages folks to vote by mail (also known as an absentee ballot). This

means you can vote without ever leaving the house! Our next election is the State Primary on August 11, then the General Presidential Election on November 3.

Free Wireless Internet in Minneapolis

Minneapolis residents and visitors can access the internet for free from 117 wireless Minneapolis hotspots throughout the city. Look for the "City of Minneapolis Public WiFi" or "USI Wireless" networks on your mobile device to get connected. You do not need a password or credit card to login. You need to be within 50 feet of the hotspots or the open public WiFi nodes. Signal strength varies indoors.
