2301 California Street Update

The proposal for 2301 California Street was approved by the Planning Commission on October 5th. Three parties have filed appeals, including Bottineau Neighborhood Association. BNA has also released a petition that, to date, has 153 signatures.

Learn more about workplace safety and paid sick leave during COVID-19

Workers have a variety of overlapping protections to navigate COVID-19 and its effects in the workplace.

The State of Minnesota and City of Minneapolis can help clarify best practices and requirements for workplace safety. Call 311, or Minnesota OSHA at 651-284-5050, to report safety problems in a business or seek additional guidance. Every COVID-19 preparedness plan must ensure that sick workers stay home. In addition to the City's Sick and Safe Time ordinance, the U.S. Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) ensures that workers are not forced to choose between their paychecks and public health.

In general, employees (of government or private sector employers with fewer than 500 employees), are entitled to (up to) two weeks (of fully or partially paid) sick leave for COVID-19 related reasons. Additional partially paid leave is available to care for a child, including during school closure or virtual learning. Private employers may be reimbursed with tax credits.

City staff have created a new page on the City's website to gather and share information on efforts to reimagine and transform Community Safety.

Minneapolis Public Schools (MPS) is offering FREE meal boxes to all youth 18 & under. This program is open to all families; youth do not need to be enrolled in MPS to receive meal boxes. Meal boxes provide a full week of meals for every kid, 18 and under, in the family. All meals meet MPS' high standards for nutrition and quality ingredients, ranging from comforting favorites like pizza and tamales to new tastes like local watermelon radishes. Families can pick-up free meal boxes at [sites](#) across Minneapolis, Monday-Friday (school days) -- including Edison High School. Most sites are open 11 a.m. to 3 p.m., and a handful of sites have extended hours of 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. Youth, parents, or siblings can pick up one box for each child in their family, per week. 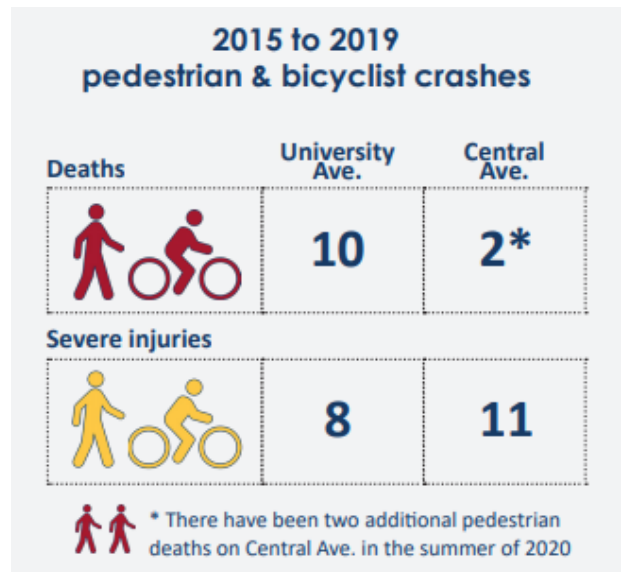
Help create a vision for University Ave. and Central Ave.
