**Parks for All** is a new draft comprehensive plan that will set Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board (MPRB) priorities and policy direction for the next decade. A series of Community Virtual Open Houses is planned for anyone to get up to speed on the project, provide feedback on the draft plan, and ask staff questions. Open house dates:

Monday, April 26, 5-6 pm Tuesday, May 18, 5-6 pm Thursday, June 24, 5-6 pm

Minneapolis community members, park users, MPRB staff and partners are encouraged to review the plan and send feedback. Your input is welcome whether you have been deeply involved in the planning process over the past two years or if you are hearing about this for the first time!



Following the public comment period, the draft plan will be revised based on public input and presented to MPRB Commissioners for review and approval. 

### Banaadir Elementary: Now Enrolling for the 2021-2022 School Year

Located at 1800 2nd St NE, Banaadir Elementary serves students in grades K-4 and shares the building with a Chance to Grow and Turnquist Child Center. Relocated from South Minneapolis, Banaadir Elementary offers a tuition-free academic experience designed by educators, parents/guardians and leaders in the Minnesota Somali community. Students progress through Banaadir Elementary and Banaadir Academy to become responsible, competent and prepared life-long learners, as well as conscientious citizens. Focused on the culture of the Somali Community, Banaadir Elementary prides itself on meeting the needs of all of the students that walk through the doors. Banaadir Elementary offers transportation to and from school for all students living in the Minneapolis and surrounding areas.

Somali Language and Culture class is offered to all students and Somali family liaisons are present in the building to help families become accustomed to the school. Teachers pride themselves on individualized instruction, rigorous lessons, and making sure all students are successful. Teachers communicate with families through phone calls and WhatsApp. This allows a partnership to take place between home and school.

Banaadir Elementary provides one to one chrome books for students so learning can continue at home. Banaadir Elementary operates on full school days Monday through Thursday and early release days on Fridays. Teachers and staff use this time on Friday afternoons for professional development and planning. Banaadir Elementary partners with Banaadir Academy in North Minneapolis (grades 5-12) to provide a K-12 education experience.

Along with Somali Language and Culture class, students will also participate in gym class, spend time outside at the nearby park, complete hands-on experiments in science, and become excellent readers and mathematicians. Students know that when they enter the building, they will be greeted with a smile, because every staff member respects and cares for all of the students.


